When you visit our webpage, we collect information you submit. For example, we collect information from you when you use visit the website to excuse a student's absence. That information includes, but may not be limited to, your student's name, the parent's or guardian's email address, the dates of the absence(s) being excused, and the reason for the student's absence. We also collect cookies for Google analytics, which allow search engines to better connect users with our webpage.

We understand that, because we use a locked SquareSpace server, your data is protected. Additionally, we understand that, this server does not actually store data you share with us. Rather, we understand that those entries are stored in a Google sheet inside, a secure Google drive.
